B. PETITION TO REJECT APPROVAL FOR REDEVELOPMENT OF TESCO & HOMEBASE SITES DELIVERED TO CITY HALL

On Wednesday 12 May, we delivered a petition with 4,332 signatures to City Hall to our newly elected London Assembly Member for London South West, Nick Rogers, who has presented the petition on our behalf to the Mayor of London.

The documentation relating to these planning applications has not yet been sent from the Council to the Mayor. As soon as he receives it, he has 14 days in which to decide whether to accept Hounslow Council's decision to approve these planning applications. We know that the odds are stacked against us, but we are trying every avenue available to us to get Hounslow Council's decision to turn those 2 sites into a mass of overcrowded, out of character tower blocks rejected.

The Big Ask national survey is the largest consultation with children and young people in England ever conducted.

D. NHS APP FOR SMARTPHONES

We have encouraged you in the past to sign up to on-line NHS services via your GP practice website.

The NHS app is another way of connecting easily to many NHS services online and we encourage you to download this app onto your smartphone if you have one. This app was launched last year but the registration process was quite cumbersome. The process is now simpler and quicker, so please do persevere. NB - It is not the same as the NHS COVID-19 Test and Trace app.

You can use this app to order repeat prescriptions, book appointments and check your medical records. It will in future hold your vaccine passport, and it will be expanded to provide many other services eg view your hospital and other healthcare appointments.
